

CASES CLOSED FOR THE FIRST TIME




JURY TRIALS HELD BY MONTH AND QUARTER

The number of jury trials held in Q2 decreased by 95% in 2020 compared to the average of the previous 2 years.




JURY TRIALS RESCHEDULED BY MONTH AND QUARTER
